

Describe what happened in the Gospel (or other readings) today?

In the Gospel, Peter recognizes that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. Because of this Jesus tells Peter that he will lead the church as its "rock." Jesus gives Peter the "keys" to Heaven so that he and the other followers can lead with the same authority that Jesus leads with.

What did you learn from the reading described above or the priest's homily?

I learned that even though Peter was not perfect, his faith allowed him to recognize who Jesus really was. If we have faith, even though we are not perfect, we can come to know Jesus the same way. Those without faith may respect Jesus, but only with faith can we call him the Son of God.
