Religious Education Program Guidelines 2017-2018

- Parents, please arrive at Blessed Sacrament at least 10 minutes before class begins. Students will be allowed in their respective classrooms when their catechist arrives. Please be on time as late arrivals are disruptive.
- Mass attendance is critical for your child (ren) and this can only happen if they see that it is a priority in your life. Mass times at Blessed Sacrament are at Saturday 5:00pm and Sunday at 9:30am (Spanish), 11:00am, 12:15pm and 5:00pm.
- As the safety and security of your child (ren) is of the utmost concern, only students, catechist, and scheduled volunteers are to be in the area where we meet before class.
- Children will be dismissed by their catechist and will only be released to a parent, guardian or a designated pick up person.

IN THE CLASSROOM:

- Due to food allergies, **NO FOOD or DRINK** is allowed in the classroom.
- *For children that might have cell phones, the phones are to be turned off during class. If your child texts or uses the phone during class, the catechist will take the phone and give it to Mr. Rachid Murad and you will be able to pick it up from his office.*

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

- Class attendance is critical. If your child will be absent please call Mr. Rachid at 516-568-1027 and leave a message. Any child with **THREE** or more absences will not be promoted to the next grade level if there has not been a good faith effort on the part of the parent to work with Mr. Rachid on any prolonged or multiple absences issues.
